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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS; February 1, 1926.

GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 5,507,774 pounds of creamery and 77,761 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 68.69% from last year and 44.07% from last month, and dairy butter also shows decreases of 82.80% from last year and 43.22% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 18,144,167 pounds showing an increase of 78.75% over last year, and a decrease of 18.99% from last month.

Eggs show 1,563,015 dozen in cold storage; 284,606 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,222,865 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 369.83% over last year and a decrease of 56.57% from last month; other than cold storage show an increase of 28.41% over last year and a decrease of 22.24% from last month; and frozen eggs show increases of 62.58% over last year and 110.60% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,447,428 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,124,419 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,993,573 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 5,602,638 pounds; and in process of cure 8,923,146 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 75.66% from last year and increased 65.52% over last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 1.74% from last year and an increase of 28.43% over last month; cured, dry salted have increased 7.16% over last year and 49.36% over last month; cured, sweet pickled show decreases of 44.07% from last year and 14.20% from last month; and stocks in process of cure a decrease of 21.45% from last year and an increase of 20.88% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,705,069 pounds and comparative figures show a decrease of 14.41% from last year and an increase of 27.03% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 8,981,032 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,107,813 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 247,346 pounds of cured and 235,227 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef show decreases of 51.28% from last year and 36.22% from last month; fresh, not frozen show increases of .83% over last year and 11.63% over last month; cured beef decreased 2.78% from last year and 14.38% from last month, and beef in process of cure also shows decreases of 14.22% from last year and 21.69% from last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,197,806 pounds of fresh frozen and 171,750 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 74.08% from last year and 72.55% from last month and fresh, not frozen veal shows an increase of 28.25% over last year and a decrease of 2.83% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 4,264,404 pounds of frozen and 201,895 pounds of not frozen stocks. Frozen stocks show decreases of 19.97% from last year and 9.45% from last month, while not frozen stocks show increases of 15.36% over last year and 73.66% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 308,589 pounds; chickens 2,953,666 pounds; fowl 946,105; ducks 71,449 pounds; geese 75,426 pounds; turkeys 925,043 pounds; unclassified 886,930 pounds. Total poultry show decreases of 22.20% from last year and 9.02% from last month.

Fish stocks show 11,815,350 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,549,189 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 11.72% from last year and 14.37% from last month, while other fish in cold storage shows increases of 26.51% over last year and 16.34% over last month.


