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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, March, 1, 1926.
GENERAL SUMMARY

The butter in storage amounts to 3,265,965 pounds of creamery and 156,763 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 73.49% from last year and 40.74% from last month, and dairy butter shows a decrease of 59.84% from last year and an increase of 99.71% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 15,101,638 pounds showing an increase of 118.16% over last year and a decrease of 16.81% from last month.

Eggs show 382,980 dozen in cold storage; 415,563 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,038,274 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 259.42% over last year and a decrease of 75.86% from last month; other than cold storage show increases of 26.81% over last year and 46.19% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 49.29% over last year and a decrease of 15.09% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 9,073,572 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,882,148 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,378,876 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,647,761 pounds; and in process of cure 8,244,399 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 64.64% from last year and increased 40.74% over last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show an increase of 1.64% over last year and a decrease of 8.20% from last month; cured, dry salted stocks show decreases of 46.40% from last year and 30.83% from last month; cured, sweet pickled have decreased 20.09% from last year and increased 36.35% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 31.44% from last year and 1.75% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,447,469 pounds being an increase of 3.38% over last year and 27.24% over last month.


Beef stocks amount to 5,346,633 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,578,859 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 224,477 pounds of cured and 171,553 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 59.55% from last year and 40.69% from last month; fresh, not frozen show increases of 51.13% over last year and 2.48% over last month; cured beef increased 2.83% over last year and decreased 9.24% from last month and beef in process of cure shows decreases of 44.42% from last year and 27.07% from last month.

Veal in storage shows 698,889 pounds of fresh frozen and 140,987 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 43.02% from last year and 42.24% from last month, while not frozen stocks show an increase of 33.09% over last year and a decrease of 18.51% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 3,607,977 pounds of frozen and 99,717 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show stocks to have decreased as follows:- frozen stocks 24.24% from last year and 15.44% from last month; not frozen stocks 1.01% from last year and 51.43% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 385,827 pounds; chickens 2,902,885 pounds; fowl 951,473 pounds; ducks 60,276 pounds; geese 69,301 pounds; turkeys 374,740 pounds, unclassified 506,670 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 22.75% from last year and 7.23% from last month.

Fish stocks show 9,572,685 pounds of fresh frozen and 2,311,970 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 10.78% from last year and 19.04% from last month, while other fish in cold storage also shows decreases of 36.68% from last year and 51.36% from last month.



Statement of Food Commodities in Storage on March 1, 1926 and a five year average as at March 1st.


