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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, APRIL 1, 1926.

The butter in storage amounts to 2,237,923 pounds of creamery and 51,768 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 62.14% from last year and 30.70% from last month, and dairy butter also shows decreases of 78.57% from last year and 66.76% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 12,323,793 pounds showing an increase of 117.30% over last year and a decrease of 18.30% from last month.

Eggs show 364,802 dozen in cold storage; 507,812 dozen other than cold storage; and 1,026,535 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 34.81% over last year and a decrease of 2.71% from last month; eggs, other than cold storage show increases of 20.42% over last year and 26.11% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 117.55% over last year and a decrease of 1.13% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 11,227,815 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,075,144 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,714,653 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,749,827 pounds; and in process of cure 8,044,925 pounds. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 59.57% from last year and increased 23.97% over last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of .50% from last year and an increase of 6.99% over last month; cured, dry salted pork shows a decrease of 34.39% from last year and an increase of 30.59% over last month; cured, sweet pickled pork decreased 26.41% from last year and increased 1.26% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 37.52% from last year and 8.38% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,996,364 pounds being an increase of 17.66% over last year and 16.29% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 4,990,755 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,695,853 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 182,577 pounds of cured; and 216,642 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 52.40% from last year and 6.31% from last month; fresh, not frozen show an increase of 15.05% over last year and a decrease of 14.94% from last month; cured beef decreased 47.58% from last year and 18.67% from last month; while beef in process of cure shows increases of 68.32% over last year and 23.92% over last month.

Veal in storage shows 395,963 pounds of fresh frozen and 219,346 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 51.02% from last year and 42.77% from last month; while fresh veal, not frozen, shows increases of 69.92% over last year and 57.38% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 2,789,605 pounds of frozen and 107,394 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 26.27% from last year and 22.67% from last month, while not frozen stocks show an increase of 27.90% over last year and 10.59% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 218,749 pounds; chickens 2,414,911 pounds; fowl 885,311 pounds; ducks 94,652 pounds; geese 77,236 pounds; turkeys 711,225 pounds; unclassified 343,635 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 22.31% from last year and 17.16% from last month.

Fish stocks show 7,902,340 pounds of fresh frozen and 1,867,770 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Comparative figures show stocks to have decreased as follows:- fresh frozen 9.87% from last year and 17.39% from last month, and other in cold storage 15.92% from last year and 19.21% from last month.


