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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MAY 1, 1926.

The butter in storage amounts to 2,819,211 pounds of creamery and 14,670 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 23.26% over last year and 24.41% over last month, while dairy butter shows decreases of 92.64% from last year and 74.52% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 11,896,840 pounds in store showing an increase of 13.03% over last year and a decrease of 3.45% from last month.

Eggs show 3,432,401 dozen in cold storage; 440,144 dozen other than cold storage; and 942,757 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 23.49% from last year and an increase of 949.99% over last month; eggs, other than cold storage show decreases of 36.58% from last year and 14.93% from last month, and frozen eggs increased 84.13% over last year and decreased 8.16% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- Fresh frozen 13,183,559 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,951,924 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,113,810 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,155,135 pounds; and in process of cure 9,370,772 pounds. When compared with last year's figures, stocks show the following decreases respectively:- fresh frozen 57.45%; fresh, not frozen 6.47%; cured, dry salted 32.44%; cured, sweet pickled 28.02%; and in process of cure 18.71%. Comparisons with last month's figures show that fresh frozen stocks increased 17.33%; fresh, not frozen decreased 5.00%; Cured, dry salted increased 19.51%; cured, sweet pickled decreased 4.60%; and stocks in process of cure increased 13.34%.

The lard in storage amounts to 4,484,582 pounds, being an increase of .02% over last year and 13.90% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 3,960,460 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,159,925 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 159,020 pounds of cured and 193,802 pounds of beef in process of cure. When compared with last year's figures fresh frozen beef shows a decrease of 57.34%; fresh, not frozen an increase of 10.90%; cured, a decrease of 52.31%; and beef, in process of cure an increase of 14.93%. Comparisons with last month's figures show stocks to have decreased as follows:- fresh frozen beef 19.41%; fresh, not frozen 11.59%; cured 13.45%; and stocks in process of cure 8.05%.

Veal in storage amounts to 325,866 pounds of fresh frozen and 336,089 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 40.71% from last year and 18.72% from last month, and fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 4.25% from last year and an increase of 52.20% over last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 1,837,086 pounds of frozen and 62,961 pounds of not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 28.24% from last year and 34.13% from last month, and stocks, not frozen also show decreases of 26.33% from last year and 42.90% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 124,932 pounds; chickens 1,752,147 pounds; fowl 560,110 pounds; ducks 31,040 pounds; geese 69,836 pounds; turkeys 641,960 pounds; unclassified 198,908 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 29.43% from last year and 29.19% from last month.

Fish stocks show 6,686,747 pounds of fresh frozen and 2,259,353 pounds of other in cold storage. Comparative figures show decreases in fresh frozen stocks of 34.18% from last year and 14.74% from last month, and other fish in cold storage show a decrease of 21.21% from last year and an increase of 22.11% over last month.
