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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JUNE 1, 1926.

The butter in storage amounts to 4,203,022 pounds of creamery and 77,252 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 41.83% over last year and 50.44% over last month, while dairy butter shows a decrease of 58.70% from last year and an increase of 432.44% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 13,246,837 pounds in store showing a decrease of 14.14% from last year and an increase of 11.37% over last month.

Eggs show 9,618,454 dozen in cold storage; 623,219 dozen, other than cold storage and 992,776 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 3.18% from last year and an increase of 171.62% over last month; eggs, other than cold storage show increases of 2.73% over last year and 42.79% over last month, and frozen eggs also show increases of 52.84% over last year and 5.30% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 13,831,975 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,708,646 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,548,540 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,321,290 pounds; and in process of cure 10,955,043 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen pork to have decreased 53.20% from last year and increased 4.92% over last month; fresh pork, not frozen, shows decreases of 15.77% from last year and 8.70% from last month; cured, dry salted shows increases of 7.54% over last year and 24.32% over last month; cured, sweet pickled, shows decreases of 18.43% from last year and 1.18% from last month; and in process of cure a decrease of 10.56% from last year and an increase of 19.71% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,053,359 pounds, being a decrease of 3.61% from last year and an increase of 12.46% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 3,047,157 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,083,281 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 149,782 pounds of cured and 227,589 pounds of beef in process of cure. When compared with last year's figures fresh frozen beef shows a decrease of 57.74%; fresh, not frozen an increase of 11.48%; cured beef a decrease of 62.82% and beef in process of cure an increase of 23.35%. Comparisons with last month's figures show fresh frozen beef to have decreased 24.38%; fresh, not frozen decreased 2.04%; cured beef decreased 6.22%; and beef, in process of cure shows an increase of 17.43%.

Veal in storage amounts to 335,855 pounds of fresh frozen and 324,585 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen veal shows a decrease of 29.60% from last year and an increase of 3.12% over last month; and fresh, not frozen stocks show an increase of 33.25% over last year and a decrease of 3.49% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 885,906 pounds of frozen and 89,901 pounds of stocks not frozen. Comparative figures show frozen stocks to have decreased 43.84% from last year and 51.80% from last month; and stocks not frozen show an increase of 4.83% over last year and an increase of 42.79% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 62,363 pounds; chickens 1,453,093 pounds; fowl 432,697 pounds; ducks 34,465 pounds; goose 62,862 pounds; turkeys 604,237 pounds; unclassified 156,685 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 30.16% from last year and 17.18% from last month.

Fish stocks show 7,485,490 pounds of fresh frozen and 2,443,097 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Comparative figures show fresh frozen fish to have decreased 32.22% from last year and increased 11.44% over last month and other fish in cold storage also shows a decrease of 21.24% from last year and an increase of 10.10% over last month.
