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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JULY 1, 1926

The butter in storage amounts to 14,372,384 pounds of creamery and 314,195 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 29.31% over last year and 242.23% over last month, while dairy butter shows a decrease of 14.39% from last year and an increase of 292.25% over last month. Cheese stocks total 18,966,045 pounds in store showing a decrease of 8.40% from last year and an increase of 43.38% over last month.

Eggs show 13,169,058 dozen in cold storage; 696,370 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,213,414 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of .44% from last year and an increase of 38.50% over last month; eggs, other than cold storage show increases of 17.69% over last year and 8.31% over last month, and frozen eggs show increases of 24.84% over last year and 22.24% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 12,136,878 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,011,236 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,268,018 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 9,003,117 pounds; and in process of cure 8,722,322 pounds. Comparisons with last year's figures show the following decreases:- fresh frozen stocks 47.22%; fresh, not frozen 24.90%; cured, dry salted 32.42%; cured, sweet pickled 13.75%; and stocks in process of cure 21.13%. Comparisons with last month's figures show the following:- fresh frozen stocks, a decrease of 12.26%; fresh, not frozen a decrease of 23.87%; cured, dry salted, a decrease of 10.86%; cured, sweet pickled, an increase of 25.05%, and stocks in process of cure, a decrease of 19.49%.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,167,415 pounds, being a decrease of 9.75% from last year and an increase of 3.25% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 2,690,993 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,954,529 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 211,841 pounds of cured, and 1,289,158 pounds of beef, in process of cure. When compared with last year's figures fresh frozen beef shows a decrease of 47.25%, fresh, not frozen, an increase of 69.57%; cured beef, a decrease of 2.58%; and beef in process of cure an increase of 460.62%. Comparisons with last month's figures show fresh frozen beef to have decreased 11.13%; fresh, not frozen increased 21.34%; cured beef increased 41.43% and beef in process of cure also increased 473.24%.

Veal in storage amounts to 543,860 pounds of frozen and 393,351 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen veal shows a decrease of 18.33% from last year and an increase of 61.72% over last month, while veal, not frozen shows increases of 28.77% over last year and 22.78% over last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 255,008 pounds of frozen and 171,211 pounds of not frozen stocks. Frozen stocks show decreases of 72.55% from last year and 71.18% from last month, while stocks, hot frozen show increases of 63.60% over last year and 90.44% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 69,891 pounds; chickens 1,052,601 pounds; fowl 220,906 pounds; ducks 25,226 pounds; geese 52,969 pounds, turkeys 546,086 pounds; unclassified 111,111 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 35.14% from last year and 26.22% from last month.

Fish stocks show 11,572,153 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,745,486 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Comparative figures show fresh frozen fish to have decreased 14.58% from last year and increased 54.66% over last month, and other fish in cold storage also shows a decrease of 13.41% from last year and an increase of 55.09% over last month.


