COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, AUGUST 1, 1926.

The butter in storage amounts to 28,023,858 pounds of creamery and 637,653 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increase of 77.32% over last year and 97.16% over last month and dairy butter also shows increases of 29.68% over last year and 102.17% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 34,430,187 pounds in store showing increases of 48.12% and 82.05% over last year and last month respectively.

Eggs show 14,688,582 dozen in cold storage; 495,777 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,322,777 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 2.83% from last year and an increase of 9.52% over last month; eggs, other than cold storage show decreases of 43.08% from last year and 34.12% from last month, while frozen eggs show increases of 56.70% over last year and 9.01% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 9,783,829 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,295,687 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,709,516 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 9,351,112 pounds; and in process of cure 9,699,740 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 40.09% from last year and 20.76% from last month. Stocks showing increases over last year and last month respectively are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 2.19% and 12.12%; cured, dry salted 20.91% and 16.66%; cured, sweet pickled 5.71% and 3.37%, while stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 5.85% from last year and an increase of 9.75% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,953,825 pounds, showing increases of 19.80% over last year and 15.12% over last month.

Beef stocks amount to 2,508,174 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,205,215 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 376,700 pounds of cured beef; and 233,875 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows decreases of 43.00% from last year and 7.15% from last month; fresh, not frozen shows an increase of 1.84% over last year and a decrease of 16.40% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 79.25% over last year and 77.82% over last month, while beef in process of cure shows decreases of 1.25% and 81.82% from last year and last month respectively.

Veal in storage amounts to 704,367 pounds of fresh frozen and 368,539 pounds of fresh, not frozen stocks. Fresh frozen veal shows increases of 26.67% over last year and 29.51% over last month and stocks not frozen show an increase of 16.44% over last year and a decrease of 4.84% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 357,945 pounds of frozen and 156,425 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 47.21% from last year and an increase of 40.10% over last month and stocks not frozen show decreases of 1.49% from last year and 9.59% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 91,894 pounds; chickens 625,243 pounds; fowl 169,540 pounds; ducks 19,915 pounds; geese 43,549 pounds; turkeys 366,586 pounds; unclassified 96,273 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 41.48% and 32.03% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks show 12,900,470 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,875,536 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Comparative figures show fresh frozen fish to have decreased 18.23% from last year and increased 18.84% over last month, while other fish in cold storage shows a decrease of 25.30% from last year and an increase of 2.21% over last month.
