COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1926.

The butter in storage amounts to 32,648,181 pounds of creamery and 1,286,995 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 58.85% over last year and 16.51% over last month and dairy butter shows increases of 92.67% over last year and 102.12% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 41,530,961 pounds in store showing increases of 35.76% and 20.45% over last year and last month respectively.

Eggs show 14,521,502 dozen in cold storage; 598,956 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,250,356 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 11.87% from last year and .03% from last month; eggs, other than cold storage show a decrease of 4.02% from last year and an increase of 20.99% over last month, while frozen eggs decreased 3.73% from last year and 5.58% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:-fresh frozen, 7,660,229 pounds; fresh, not frozen, 2,151,449 pounds; cured, dry salted, 2,250,629 pounds; cured, sweet pickled, 2,031,082 pounds; in process of cure, 9,457,006 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 11.91% and 21.71% from last year and last month respectively. Stocks not frozen show an increase of 13.74% over last year and a decrease of 9.91% from last month; cured, dry salted, show an increase of 14.39% over last year and a decrease of 17.47% from last month; cured, sweet pickled, show an increase of 4.89% over last year and a decrease of 13.65% from last month and stocks in process of cure also show an increase of 1.61% over last year and a decrease of 6.00% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,571,770 pounds, showing an increase of 38.44% over last year and a decrease of 7.33% from last month.

Beef stocks amount to 3,340,172 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,854,700 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 307,119 pounds of cured beef; and 321,774 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows a decrease of 35.61% from last year and an increase of 31.36% over last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show increases of 7.43% over last year and 15.40% over last month; cured beef shows an increase of 28.18% over last year and a decrease of 18.49% from last month and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 1.72% from last year and an increase of 35.70% over last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 901,537 pounds of fresh frozen and 286,586 pounds of fresh, not frozen stocks. Frozen stocks show increases of 27.15% over last year and 27.39% over last month while veal, not frozen, shows an increase of 7.89% over last year and a decrease of 22.49% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 161,490 pounds of frozen and 237,346 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 68.40% from last year and 54.88% from last month, while stocks not frozen show increases of 31.54% over last year and 51.60% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 132,928 pounds; chickens 355,915 pounds; fowl 174,073 pounds; ducks 31,249 pounds; geese 34,995 pounds; turkeys 274,932 pounds; unclassified 101,138 pounds. Comparative figures show decreases in total poultry of 43.24% and 21.88% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks show 16,557,164 pounds of fresh frozen fish and 4,241,135 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows a decrease of 10.88% from last year and an increase of 23.47% over last month while other fish in cold storage show increases of .29% over last year and 5.73% over last month.


