

PAELIMINARY REPORT ON CONCENTRATED MILK PLANTS, CANADA, 1930.

There were 26 concentrated milk plants in operation in Canada in 1930, whose value of output totalled \$13,504,743. Chief among the items of production were evaporated milk, \$4,983,943; condensed milk, \$2,390,206; and skim milk powder, \$1,087,129. The amount of capital invested in this industry at the end of the year 1930 was \$8,086,430; the number of persons employed during the year was 350; the selaries and wages paid amounted to \$1,066,392; while thepatrons of the factories received for the milk and cream delivered a total of \$6,836,653. A summary of the principal statistics of the industry (capital, employees, etc.), itemized statistics of production and imports and exports are given in the following tables.
