ADVANCE REPORT ON CONCENTRATED MILK PLANTS, CANADA, 1931

Number of Factories. - The number of plants classified as concentrated milk factories in operation in Canada in 1931 was 26, distributed by provinces as follows: Ontario, 23; Nova Scotia, 1; and British Columbia, 2.


Deliveries of Milk and Cream. The quantities of milk and cream delivered to the concentrated milk plants during the year 1931 were as follows: milk, 284,529,301 pounds; butter fat in cream 608,239 pounds. The total amount paid to the patrons for the milk was \$2,899,645, and for the cream, \$134,743.

Employees and Salaries and Wages. The average number of persons employed during the year 1931 was 779, comprising 565 persons classified as "wage-earness" and 214 as "salaried employees". The total salary and wage bill for the year was \$982,984.

Production. The total value of output of the concentrated milk plants in 1931 was \$6,754,002, the principal items being evaporated milk, 45,563,046 pounds at \$3,493,063; condensed milk, 14,903,897 pounds at \$1,521,728; and milk powder (whole milk and skim milk) 12,808,338 pounds at \$1,371,648. The present report deals with the production of concentrated milk plants only, and does not take account of the small quantities of these items made in creameries.
