

## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON THE PACK OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, 1934.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics presents herewith a preliminary report on the pack of canned fruits and vegetables for the year 1934. These statistics were collected in co-operation with the Canning Division of the Dominion Department of Agriculture which furnished the Bureau at the completion of each pack with a list of firms canning each product. Statistics shown in this report comprise the whole of the fruit and vegetable canning industry including apples, baked beans, pumpkin and soups which, owing to incomplete returns, could not be given in the previous report published in January, 1935.



## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON THE PACK OF CANNED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, 1934.

Imports and exports of fruits and vegetables for the calendar years 1933 and 1934 are given in tables 3 and 4. Imports of canned fruits continued to decline. Imports of canned vegetables totalled 2,478,790 pounds as against 2,076,133 pounds in 1933. Canned fruits were lower, dropping from 21,326,891 pounds in 1933 to 20,095,005 pounds in 1934.

Exports of both canned fruits and vegetables in 1934 were, however, higher, the former increasing from 16,484,154 pounds to 24,576,688 pounds and the latter from 17,409,878 pounds to 20,707,697 pounds.
