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PRODUCTION OF DAIRY FACTORIES, CANADA, 1945

The annual statistics of dairy factories are issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the provincial departments of agriculture. The present statement deals with production only. The complete report, to be issued at a later date, will include statistics, by provinces and counties or districts, of production, deliveries of milk and cream, amounts paid to patrons, employees, salaries and wages, and other data.

Creamery Butter. - The production of creamery butter in Canada in the year 1945 amounted to 293,782,846 pounds, valued at \$101,398,478 compared with 298,777,262 pounds valued at \$101,534,710 in the preceding year. The quantity made in 1945 is the third highest in the history of the industry. The average price per pound for the year was 34.51 cents, an increase over 1944 of 0.53 cents. All provinces show increased production except Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta.

Factory Cheese. - The production of factory cheese in 1945 amounted to 187,928,315 pounds, valued at \$38,272,224, an increase in quantity over 1944 of 6,810,485 and an increase in value of \$1,613,095. The average price per pound in 1945 was 20.36 cents, compared with 20.24 cents paid in 1944. The production of cheese in Ontario represents 61 p.c. and that of Quebec 33 p.c. of the total production for the Dominion.

Total Value of Output of Dairy Factories. - The value of all products of dairy factories in 1945 amounted to \$258,984,544 compared with \$248,806,528 for the year 1944, an increase of \$10,178,016.

Number of Dairy Factories. - The total number of dairy factories in operation in 1945 was 2,270. This total includes 1,130 creameries, 927 cheese factories, 184 combined butter and cheese factories and 29 concentrated milk plants. The creameries show a decrease of 2, the cheese factories a decrease of 26, the combined butter and cheese factories a decrease of 13 and the concentrated milk plants an increase of 3.
