## PRODUCTION OF DAIRY FACTORIES, CANADA, 1946

The annual statistics of dairy factories arc issued by the Dominion Buroau fo Sta -tiatics in co-operation with the provincial dopartments of agriculturo. Tho present stotomont doals with production only. The comploto roport, to bo issucd at a later date, will include statistics, by provinces and countios or districts, of production, dolivorios of milk and crom, amounts paid to patrons, omploycos, snlaries and wagos and othor datn.

Crcamery Buttor:- The production of crearery buttor in canadn in the yenr 1946 amounted to $271,464,399$ pounds, valucd at $\$ 105,441,401$ compared with $293,782,846$ pounds valucd at $\$ 101,398,478$ in tho proceding yoar. The nverage price per pound for the yenr was 38.84 conts, an increasc over 1945 of 4.33 conts. All provinces show decreasod. productions.

Factory Chees:- The production of factory choesc in 1946 amounted to 147,647,509 pounds, valued at $\$ 30,913,936$, a decrease in quantity from 1945 of $40,280,806$ pounds and a decrease in value of $\$ 7,358,288$. The average price per pound in 1945 wes 20.94 conts, compared with 20.36 cents paid in 1945 . The production of cheese in Ontario reprosonts $54 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. and that of Quebec $29 \mathrm{p} . c$. of the total production for the Dominion.

Total Value of Output of Dairy Factories:- The vihe of all products of dairy factories in 1946 amounted to $\$ 270,305,506$ compared with $\$ 258,984,544$ for the year 1945 , an incroase of $\$ 11,320,962$.

Number of Dairy Factories:- The total number of dairy factories in operntion in 1946 was 2,194. This total includos 1,122 creameries, 868 cheese factories, 173 combined butter and cheese factories and 31 concentrated milk plants. The oreameries show a decrease of 8 , the cheese factories a decrease of 59 , the combined butter and cheese factories a decrease of 11 and the concentrated milk plants an increase of 2 .
