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## PRODUCTION OF DAIRY FACTORIES, CANADA, 1947

The annual statistics of dairy factories are issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the provincial departments of agriculture. The present statement deals with production only. The complete report, to be issued at a later date, will include statistics, by provinces and counties or districts, of production, deliveries of milk and cream, amounts paid to patrons, employees, salaries and wages and other data.

Creamery Butter: - The production of creamery butter in Canada in the year 1947 amounted to 290,952,691 pounds, valued at \$152,935,070 compared with 271,464,399 pounds, valued at \$105,441,401 in the preceding year. The average price per round for the year was 52.57 cents, an increase over 1946 of 13.73 cents. Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba, Alberta, show increased productions. Frince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Saskatchewan, British Columbia, show decreased productions,

Factory Cheese: - The production of factory cheese in 1947 amounted to 123,337. 530 pounds, valued at \$31,928,861, a decrease in quantity from 1946 of 24,309,979 pounds, an increase in value of \$1,014,925. The average price per pound in 1947 was 25.91 cents, compared with 20.94 cents jaid in 1946. The production of cheese in Ontario represents 72 p.c. and that of Quebec 21 p.c. of the total production for the Dominion.

Total Value of Output of Dairy Factories:- The value of all products of dairy factories in 1947 amounted to \$352.373.109 compared with \$270.305,506 for the year 1946, an increase of \$82,067,603.

Number of Dairy Factories: -- The total number of dairy factories in operation in 1947 was 2,068. This total includes 1,143 creameries, 741 cheese factories, 153 combined butter and cheese factories and 31 concentrated milk plants. The creameries show an increase of 21, the cheese factories a decrease of 127, the combined butter and cheese factories a decrease of 20, and the concentrated milk plants were the same in number as in 1946.

The statistics of production in this report are based on annual returns NOTE: from factories classified as industrial concerns and may differ slightly from cumulative monthly totals published in "Dairy Statistics of Canada".
