THE SASH, DOOR, AND PLANING MILL INDUSTRY IN CANADA

1927 and 1928

Ottawa, March 1930,- A report on the sash, door and planing-mill industry in Canada for 1927 and 1928 has just been compiled by the Forest Products Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. This industry includes planing-mills, and mills engaged primarily in the manufacture of builders' millwork. The chief products of the industry consisting of sash, doors, frames, blinds, millwork, moulding, matched and planed lumber amounted in 1928 to \$47,216,255 as compared to \$43,922,953 in 1927. In addition to their principal products, many of these mills manufacture also, as side lines and by-products, other wooden commodities such as boxes and containers, sporting goods, furniture and cabinetwork, vehicle supplies, boats, handles, woodenware, tanks, etc. The total value of these secondary products in 1928 was \$5,484,060 and in 1927 \$4,032,595. The total value of all the products of the industry was \$52,700,315 in 1928 and \$47,955,548 in 1927.

There were 788 establishments in this class in 1928 and 771 in 1927. Their production includes the greater part of the sash, doors and millwork made in Canada but there are a number of other establishments classified under other industrial groups that manufacture these commodities as side lines to their principal products.

The industry in 1928 gave employment to 12,131 people, consisting of 10,674 male and 110 female employees on wages and 1,099 male and 248 female employees paid on a salary basis. The total payroll in 1928 was \$13,330,829 and in 1927 \$12,211,709.

The raw materials of the industry consist chiefly of rough sawn lumber which in 1928 was used to the extent of 655,192 M ft. b.m. of softwood valued at \$18,233,435 and 138,333 M ft. of hardwood valued at \$7,309,149. Other raw materials consisted of logs and bolts of both softwood and hardwood, together with veneer, iron and steel, glass, hardware, paints, oils, etc. The total value of all materials in 1928 was \$30,021,888 and in 1927 \$26,343,318. The total value of fuel purchased was \$158,744 and the power employed in the industry amounted to over fifty-two thousand horse-power.

The total capital invested in the industry in 1928 amounted to \$53,431,576 as compared to \$50,861,269 in 1927. This capital was distributed as follows:- land, buildings, machinery and tools, 45 per cent, materials and stocks on hand, 28 per cent, cash and accounts, 27 per cent.

Details concerning these different aspects of the industry are given in the following tables the first of which is a summary, by provinces, of the principal statistics of the industry.

INDUSTRY AND TRADE

Textile Industry

The textile industry in the United States has experienced a period of significant growth and expansion in recent years. This growth is primarily due to the increasing demand for textile products, both domestically and internationally. The industry has also benefited from technological advancements and improvements in production efficiency. Key factors contributing to this growth include the expansion of the cotton and wool sectors, as well as the development of new synthetic fiber products. The industry's output has risen steadily, reflecting a strong and sustained demand for textile goods. This growth has also led to the creation of new jobs and the expansion of existing ones within the sector.

There were 100 establishments in this class in 1953 and 111 in 1954. The total value of shipments was \$1,200 million in 1953 and \$1,300 million in 1954. The average value of shipments per establishment was \$12 million in 1953 and \$11.7 million in 1954. The number of employees in this class was 100,000 in 1953 and 105,000 in 1954. The total value of shipments per employee was \$12,000 in 1953 and \$12,381 in 1954. The total value of shipments per establishment per employee was \$120 in 1953 and \$117 in 1954.




