THE ROOFING PAPER INDUSTRY, 1943

Ottawa, January, 1945. - The Roofing Paper Industry includes all establishments engaged wholly or chiefly in the manufacture of roofing paper.

There were seventeen establishments in this group in 1943 distributed as follows: Quebec 6, Ontario 4, British Columbia 3, Manitoba 2 and New Brunswick and Alberta 1 each.

The table below gives the principal statistics of this group for 1942 and 1943. The value of products was slightly higher than the previous year, and wages paid and fuel used also increased. All other items decreased or showed no change.

There were a number of establishments classed in other industrial groups which made relatively small quantities of roofing paper as a side line. Complete figures on production by all industrial groups and further details concerning this group will be given in a later report on the paper-using industries as a whole.

Ottawa, Janvier 1945. - L'industrie du papier-toiture comprend tous les établissements dont l'occupation exclusive ou principale consiste dans la fabrication de papier-toiture.

Il y avait 17 établissements dans ce groupe en 1943 distribués comme suit: Québec 6, Ontario 4, Colombie Britannique 3, Manitoba 2, Nouveau-Brunswick 1 et Alberta 1.

Le tableau ci-dessous donne les principales statistiques de l'industrie pour 1942 et 1943. La valeur des produits est supérieure à celle de l'année précédente, et les gages payés et le combustible utilisé ont aussi augmenté. Tous les autres items ont enregistré des baisses ou n'ont pas changé.

Il y a un certain nombre d'établissements classés dans d'autres groupes industriels qui produisent des quantités relativement faibles de papier-toiture en à côté. Les chiffres de la production totale de tous les groupes et des détails additionnels touchant cette industrie seront donnés dans un rapport subséquent sur toutes les industries utilisant le papier.


