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INVESTORS' INDEX NUMBERS OF SECURITY PRICES 1926_100

The "Investors'" weighted index numbers of security prices, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, were as follows for the week ending March 22nd.

The "Investo: s'" index for all three groups of common stocks combined was 95.1 for the week ending March 22nd, as compared with 97.1 for the previous week.

The "Investors'" index of industrial common stocks was 130.1 for the week ending March 22nd as compared with 133.3 for the previous week.

The "Investors" index of domestic utility common stocks was 58.8 for the week ending March 22nd, as compared with 60.3 for the previous week.

The "Investors'" index of common stocks of companies located abroad in which Canadians are heavily interested was 91.6 for the week ending March 22nd, as compared with 92.2 for the previous week.

Average weekly prices were lower for eighteen, unchanged for three and higher for four of the twenty-five best selling stocks on the Montreal and Toronto Exchanges. International Nickel fell from \$27.4 to \$26.4, Ford "A" from \$23.3 to \$22.3, Walkers from \$47.5 to \$46.3, Brazilian from \$12.4 to \$11.6, C.P.R. from \$17.7 to \$17.0, Canada Cement from \$9.4 to \$8.4, Consolidated Mining and Smelting from \$165.3 to \$163.3, Canadian Industrial Alcohol "A" from \$16.2 to \$15.3 and Canadian Dredge and Dry Dock from \$28.7 to \$25.7. Bruck Silk rose from \$20.8 to \$21.3 and Weston Ltd. from \$28.9 to \$30.0.

Sales were lower for twenty-two and higher for three stocks. International Nickel declined from 89,800 to 54,500, C.P.R. from 40,300 to 11,700, Consolidated Mining and Smelting from 5,000 to 3,200, Canada Coment from 36,400 to 7,200, Montreal Light, Heat and Power from 10,700 to 4,200, Dominion Bridge from 7,500 to 900, Brazilian from 24,800 to 11,400, Canadian Industrial Alcohol "A" from 12,900 to 6,000, Dominion Textile from 1,900 to 600 and Canadian Dredge and Dry Dock from 4,000 to 1,100. Walkers mounted from 6,400 to 7,700 and National Breweries from 3,400 to 4,300.
