## INVESTORS! INDEX NUMBERS OF SECURITY PRICES $1926=100$

The "Investors"" weighted index numbers of security prices, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926100 , were as follows for the week ending May 17th.

The "Investorsl" index for all threc groups of common stocks combined was 95.0 for the weck onding May 17th, as compared with 97.0 for the provious week.

The "Invostorsl" index of industrial cormon stocks was $12 \%$. for the wook ending May 17 th, as compared with 131.0 for the previous week.

The "Investors"l inder of domestic utility common stocks was 56.7 for the week ending May 17th, as compared with 57.7 for the previous week.

The "Investors!" index of comon stocks of companies located abroad in which Canadians arc heavily intorosted was 100.3 for tho woek onding May 17th, as compared with 101.5 for the provious weak.
