## INVESTORS' INDEX NOMBERS OF SECURITY PRICES <br> (1926=100)

The "Investors:" weighted index numbers of security prices, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base $1926=100$, were as follows for the week ending January 27th.

The "Investors:" index for all three groups of common stocks combined wan 94.5 for the week ending January 17 th, as compared with 96.4 for the previous week.

The "Investors" index of industrial conmon stocks was 130.4 for the week ending Jenuary 17 th, as compared with 133.0 for the previous week.

The "Investorsil index of domostic utility common stocks was 49.7 for tho week ending January 17th, as compared with 50.3 for tho previous wook.

The "Investors:" index of common stocks of companies located abroad in which Canadians are heavily interested was 107.8 for the week ending January 17 th, as compared with 111.1 for the previous weak.
