The Dominion Bureau of Statistics index number of wholesale prices on the base $1926=100$ foll further from 7.7 for the week anding Soptumber 28 th, to 71.2 for the wook onding October 5th. Rocossions occurrod for grains, filour and millod products, raw silk, ras cotton and most of tho non-forrous netais.

The Vagotablo Product index droppcd from $6!.9$ to 66.5 due to reductions in grains, flou- and milled products. Declines ir hidss, oils, and fats and cured meats were of more consequence then gains in livesteck and milk products and the inder of Animal Products moved dom from 66, ? to 66,4 . Lower prices for ram silk and raw cotton caused the inder of Tibres, Textiles and Fextilo Froancts to fall from 72.7 to 72.6. The Hon- Terrous inetels continued to shom realmess. Descoases moro noticod in copper, load, and sinc which wore sufficiont to change the indox from 62.0 to 61.4. In tho Chamical groxp lower pricos for logwood and quobracho cxtracts, Iump alum and coppor sulphate wore chiofly responsible for oringing the inder from 81.9 to 81.8 . Wood, Wood Products and Paper, Iron and Its Zroaucts and Non-Motailic Ninorals romainod unchangod at $65.5,86.6$ and $86 . j$ rosuectively.

The lower levels reached by grains, hay and potatoos wore the reasons for reducing the indax of Cancodian Forra Products from 60.7 to 59.1.
