The Dominion Bureau of Statistics weekly index number of wholesalo prices on the base 1926a100, was 71.0 for the wcok onding May 18, as comparod with 71.1 for tho wook precoding.

Vegetable Products dropped fractionally from 64.9 ta 64.8 , lower quotations for rye, flour, raw rubber anil potatoes being of slightly more consequence than increases for flax, oats, and wheat. Arimals and Thoir Products also foll 0.1 from 65.3 to 65.2 . because of declines for hides, leather, livestock, and lard. Fggs and cheese averaged higher. Fibres, Textiles and Textilo Products wore mehanged at 74.1. Iron and Its Products advancod from 87.3 to 87.4 , largely duo to firmor quotations for stecl sheots. Tood, Tood Products and Papor mountod from 65.7 to 65.9 with maplo lumbor and groundwood pulp moving upward. Non-Forrous Motals and Thoir Products foll from 66.1 to 65.9, principally due to docreasos for coppor sheot, domestic load, tin, and zinc, while silvor was firmer. Non-Metallic Minerals and Their Products declined from 85.8 to 85.5 , and Ohemicals and Allied Products advanced from 81.8 to 81.9
