## WITFKIY INDHX NUMBFRS OF THOIESIIE PRICES, 1934.

(1926m100)
The Dominion Bureau of Statistics index number of wholesale prices on the base 19260100 rose from 71.9 for the week onded July 13 , to 72.3 for tho week ended July 20. Frice changes recorded, showed sharp advances for grains, flour, hogs and cured moats and declines for hides and skins, stoers, lambs, calvos and frosh moats. Vegctablc Products advanced from 67.4 to 69.2 , gains for grains, and flour influoncing the index more than losses for oranges, potatoes and hay. inimal Products droppod from 66.4 to 66.2 doclines for hides, shoos, stcors, calves, lambs and butter, boing of more consequonco than advances for canned salmon, oggs, hogs and curod moats. Fibros, Textilos and Textiic Products moved down from 74.3 to 73.7 owing mainly to roducod prices for woollen cloth, and worsted cioth yarne. Mood, Tood Products and Papor changed from 66.0 to 65.9 Iue to lower quatations for spruco scantling and fir drop siding. Frice roductions for scrap iron and stenl caused tho index for . Iron and Stool Products to move dum from 87.4 to 87.1 . fon-Forrous Matals fell fractionally from 63.3 to 63.3 , with slightly casier prices for cloctrolytic copper, coppor wire bars, tin and silver. Deciines in sewer pipe quotations wero largoly responsiblo from the drop in the Non-lhetallic Minerai inces from 86.0 to 85.7 . Chomicals and dilied Products remained unchanged at 82.0 minor lossos for $z \operatorname{lnc}$ oxide and lithopono, balancing gains for creosote oil.

Cancdian Farm Products rose from 59.9 to 60.8 . Tho vogotablo group movod up from 56.8 to 59.0 clifefly because of higher prices for grains, whilc doclinos for hides and skins, and livostock caused the indox for the onimal group to fall from 65.1 for woak of July 13 to 63.8 for the weak onded July 20 .
