The Dominion Bureau of Statistics index numbor of wholosalo pricos on the baso 1926100 doclinod from 72.8 for tho mook onding october 25 , to 72.4 for the wook ending Jovamber 1 . Rocossions occurrod in grains, livostock and most of tho non-forrous motals, whilo moderato advancos moro roported for vogotablo oils, eggs and rav cotton. Vogetablo Products, Animal Products, Iron and Non-Fcrrous Motals have indoxos highor than for the corresponding week of last yoar whilc Toxtilos, Mood, Non-Motallic Mincrals and Chomicals have failod to maintain the positions thoy then held.

During tho weok, Vogotablo Products droppod from 67.7 to 66.5. Vogotablo oils and raw rubbor woro fimaor but millod products, vogotablos and grain showod roductions. Salos of grains for oxport woro disappointing at the first of tho moak, although domand picked up Intor, and Manitoba No. I Northorn wheat closod with a loss of 3 conts. inimal products foll from 73.4 to 73.0 . Hidos, curcd moats, oggs and fats roso slightly but frosb monts and milk products woro down and, although no sharp broak occurrod, umsually hoavy ruks of cattio to tho principal stock rards causod a drop in the pricos of livostock. Textilos strengthenod slightly and moved from 69.2 to 69.3 roflccting buoyancy in raw cotton and raw wool. Raw silk, on tho contrary, sufforod a sharp roaction and lost tho gains of the procoding mook. Non-Forrous Motals mero monkor, gonorally, and the inder dippod from 73.6 to 72.9 mhilo Mood Products, Iron, Nom-Motallic Minorals and Chomicals ranainod unchongod at $64.8,87.1,85.0$ and 77.4 rospoctivoly.

Canadian Fnm Products docronsod from 65.2 to 63.9. Fiold Products foll from 57.8 to 56.0 with lowor pricos for grains chicfly responsible whilo weaknoss in livom stock was largely tho roason of a doclino in Animal Products of from 77.5 to 77.0 .
