The Dominion Bureau of Statistjes index number of wholesale prices on the base 292am 100 edvencon from 72.5 for the moce onding April 12 to 72.7 for tho weok anding Aprs 19. Fooi Products made goins and Non Forrous Mctals continuod to advance Thile Toxitiles and Jood Products more sigignty lowor.

Vegotablo Products rose from 69.3 to 69.7. Grains wero highor with the oxception of wheat which cascd slightly, whilo milled products, vegetablo oils and ram sugar were fizm. The livostock narkess were quieter than for the previous woek but small gains were mace in the prices paid for cattle. Fresh meats sold higher and egga rallied when ufferings from Testori Canada zere greatly reduced. Botter prices were quotec for raw wool but roductions in raw silks and cotton fabrics decreased the index for Textiles irom 70.6 to 70.5 . Moderate rccossions in B.C. fir and a lowor avorage for wiprood changed the index for Wood ?roducts from 64. 4 to 64.0. Substantial advances in scrap iron exerted more influence than lossos in steel rolling mill products and raised the jndar for Iron from 87.0 to 57.4 . Non-Forrous Metals were still active and rose from 67.7 to 67.8 . Coprer was comparatively quiet and up. Silvor experienced a mild recession but average remained stationary at 85,8 and 80,3 respectively.

Uainäian Tarm Products rose frou 65.1 to 65.2. Better prices for grains were largely responsible for raising the inder of Field Products from 60.0 to 60.5 while reductions in milk products provod of nor importence than gains in livestock and hides and decreaced the inder for inimals from 73,7 to 73,0 .
