WEEKLY INDEX NUMBERS OF WHOLESALE PRICES, 1939-1940

Following a decline of two weeks, Industrial Material prices rallied, and the Bureau's index, on the base August 1939=100, rose from 121.9 for the week ending May 3 to 122.2 for the week ending May 10. The Stable group remained unchanged at 112.6, but the Sensitive section advanced from 128.5 to 129.0. Manufacturing Materials moved up .5 to 127.6, as gains for rubber, silk and tin ingots outweighed losses for raw cotton and cottonseed oil, while Food Materials showed a rise from 132.2 to 132.6, due chiefly to higher prices for oats.

The index for General Wholesale Commodities, on the base 1926-100, moved down from 53.0 to 52.8 between the weeks of May 3 and 10. The most important price changes occurred in the Vegotable, Animal, Textile and Non-Ferrous Metal groups. Vegetable Products receded from 76.0 to 75.8, declines in grains, vegotable oils and potatoes outwoighing gains for raw rubber and cocca. Higher prices for fish and meats were outbalanced by declines for furs, hides, livestock and eggs, and the index for Animal Products fell from 76.7 to 76.2. Owing to easier prices for raw cotton, Textiles moved down from 53.6 to 83.4. Wood Products advanced from 87.3 to 87.4, and Non-Ferrous Metals from 76.5 to 76.5, the rise in the latter being due to backaps quotations for copper, tin and zinc. Iron, Non-Metallic Minerals and Chemicals were unchanged at 102.3, 87.1 and 85.6 respectively.

Canadian Farm Products decreased from 71.6 to 71.3, with losses registered in both the Field Products and Animal Products groups.
