## WEEKIY INDEX NMBBERS OF WEOLFSALE PRICES, 1939-1940

Following a decline of two wooks, Industrial Material pricos ralliod, and tho Bureau's indow, on tho bas. iugust $1939=100$, roso from 121.9 for tho weok onding May 3 to $122_{0} 2$ fo* the wook ending May 10. The Stable group remained unchanged at 112.6, but the Senstivive soction advanced from 128.5 to 129.0 . Manufacturing Materlals moved up .5 to 127.6 , as gains for rubber, silk and tin ingots outweighed lossos fa, raw cotton and cottonseed oil, while Food Matcrials showed a rise from 132.2 to 132.6, due chiefly to higher nisioss for onta.

The iniux for Goneral Wholesale Comodities, on the base 1926 100 , moved down from 53.0 to 82.5 betwoon the weeks of May 3 and 10. The most important price changes occurrod in the Veguteble, Animal, Textile and Non-Ferrous Metal groups. Vegetabio Products receded from 76.0 to 75.8 , declines in grains, vogotablo oils and potatoes outwuishing gains for raw rubber and cocoa. Higher pricos for fish and meate wero outbentancud iy doclinos for furs, hidos, livostock and eggs, and the indox for Animal Eroducta foll from 76.7 to 76.2 . Owing to easier prices fo. raw cotton, Textiles moved down from 33.6 to 83.4 . Wood Products advanced from 87.3 to 87.4 , and Non-Ferrous Metals fron 76.3 to 76.5 , the rise in the latter being due to bikivs quotations for copper, tin and aine. Iron, Non-Metallic Minerals and Chemicals were unchanged at 102.3. 87.1 and 85.6 respectively.

Camazas Farm products decrcasod from 71.6 to 71.3 . with losses rogisterod in both tho Fiold Froducts and Animal Products groups.
