is furthor reduction in Industrial Matorial prices lowered the Dominion Burenu of Statisticsi indox, on tho baso August 1939=100, from 119.1 for the rook of July 5 to 118.8 for the week of July 12. This was the fourth successive week of decline and the index touched the lowost point sinco tho wook of Octobor 13, 1939. The Stable group remainod at 113.4 , whilo price movoments in tho Manufacturing and Food Matorial groups "ero at variance. The formor dropped from 120.7 to 119.6 , whon ram rubbor, cot tonseod o11. raw cotton and ram silk woakonod, but Food Naterials roso from 129.0 to 230. 4 , as quotations for stoors and hogs boceme firmor.

General Tholesale Comodities receded also, moving from 82.2 to 81.7. Vegetable Products and Toxtiles movod lowor, whilo Animal Froducts and Chemicals made modost advancos.

Canadian Farm Products foll from 65.8 to 65.0 . Duo to moro plontiful suppiles of now potatoos, pricos dropped sharply in some centres. This was mainly responsible for decreasing the index for Hiold products from 54.6 to 53.2 , while Animal Products rose from 84.3 to 84.7 , bocause of highor quotations for livestock, hides and egge.
