## TEMKLY INDEX NUNBERS OF WHOLBSALE ERICES, 1940-194!

The general wholesale commodity price index of the Dominion Buroau of Statistics continuod to move slightly lower from 91.1 for the wook onding July 25 to 91.0 for the wook onding August 1 (1926 w 100 ). The Vogotablc Eroducte and Toxtilos Froduct groups docilnod, whilo advences prodominatod in Animai Eroducts and Non-Notallic Minorals. Flour prices wore roducod when the tax of 15 conts por bushol was removed from whoat procossod for uso in Canods. Other commoditios to sell lowor included graine, green coffee beans, raw cotton, raw wool and tin ingots. Increases occurred in ram rubber, potatoos, loather, livostocis, fresh meats, lard and plato glass.

Industrial Material Prices, on the base August 2939100 . mounted from 139.2 to 139.3. The Stable price serios remained at l24. 5, but tho Sonsitive group, including Mamfacturing and Food Materials, rose from 249.9 to 150 . . The former advanced from 150.8 to 151.3 , when declines in raw cotton and tinn ingots failed to offsot highor pricos for raw rubbor and beof hidos. Food Materials fell from 147.6 to 146.8 , as small increases in oats, steers and hogs rere insufficient to counteract a drop in wheat.

Canadian Farm Froducte moved from 71.8 to 71.2. Field Products dropped from 57.0 to 55.7, when a decline in grains proved of more importance than increasos in hay and potatoos. Animal Products roso from 96.7 to 97,2 , as advancos in ilvostock, hides and ogge outwoighod a docrase in wool.
