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## WEI GHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

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1926=100
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The weighted index of seventeen mining stocks, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base of $1926=100$, was 118.9 for the week ending September 27 th, as compared with 120.0 for the meek ending September 20 th.

Gold copper stocks, represented by Noranda and Amulet, fell from 278.8 to 272.1. Eleven gold stocks fell from 90.4 to 90.2 . Four silver and miscellaneous stocks went up from 73.3 to 75.1 .

Among the gold stocks the average weekiy prices behaved as follows:Coniaurum fell from $\$ 3.32$ to $\$ 2.57$, Dome from $\$ 9.50$ to $\$ 9.26$, Mcintyre from $\$ 21.76$ to $\$ 21.62$ and Wright-Hargreaves from $\$ 3.14$ to $\$ 3.05$. Folliger rose from $\$ 8.55$ to $\$ 8.63$, Lake Shore from $\$ 22.24$ to $\$ 22.36$ and Sylvanite from 2.77 to $\$ 2.83$.

Average prices were higher for one of the gold conper stccks and lower for the other. Amulet rose from $\$ 3.25$ to $\$ 3.33$ and Noranda fell from $\$ 52.25$ to $\$ 50.79$.

In the silver and miscellaneous group the average price of Boniagas rose from $\$ 3.00$ to $\$ 3.50$. Mining Corporation fell from $\$ 3.31$ to $\$ 3.29$.
