

WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

1926 = 100

The weighted index of seventeen mining stacks computed by the Dominich Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926 - 100, was 113.9 for the week ending December 20th, as compared with 110.1 for the week ending December 13th.

Gold copper stocks, represented by Amulet and Noranda rose from 290.0 to 314.9. Eleven gold stocks fell from 75.5 to 75.4. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks fell from 71.3 to 71.0.

Among the gold stocks the average weekly prices behaved as follows:

Dome rose from \$8.91 to \$9.08, Hollinger from \$8.15 to \$8.34 and Lake Shore from \$16.72 to \$10.83. Premier fell from \$2.21 to \$2.16, Coniaurum from \$1.20 to \$1.05, McIntyre from \$20.52 to \$19.96 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$1.60 to \$1.52.

Average prices were higher for both of the gold copper stocks. Amulet rose from \$2.78 to \$2.87 and Noranda from \$55.42 to \$60.38.

In the silver and miscellaneous group the average price of nipissing fell from \$3.74 to \$3.55. Mining Corporation rose from \$3.54 to \$3.64.
