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## WEIGHTED INDEX NURBERS OF 17 KINING STOCKS

$1926=100$

The weighted index of seventeen mining stocks computed by tho Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base of $1926=100$ was 123.5 for the week ending September 13 th as compared with 125.3 for the week ending September 6 th.

Gold copper stocks, represented by Noranda and Amuletifell from 293.5 to 289.9. Eleven gold stocks fell from 93.6 to 92.1 . Four silver and miscellaneous stocks fell from 80,4 to 79.9.

Among the gold stocks the average weekly prices behaved as follows:Dome rose from $\$ 8.78$ to $\$ 9.51$, Kirkland Lake from $\$ 1152$ to $\$ 1.56$ and Sylvanite from $\$ 2.69$ to $\$ 2.96$. Hollinger fell from $\$ 8.89$ to 8166 , MicIntyre from $\$ 23.52$ to \$22.41, Lake Shore from 23.19 to 22.40, Teck-Hughes from \$9.27 to \$9,08 and Wright-Hargreaves from $\$ 3.44$ to $\$ 3.32$.

Average prices were lower for both of the gold copper stocks. Amulet fell from $\$ 3.63$ to $\$ 3.42$ and Noranda from $\$ 54.70$ to $\$ 54.25$.

In the silver and miscellaneous groups the average price of Nipissing fell from $\$ 3.30$ to $\$ 3.28$ and Mining Corporation from $\$ 3.39$ to $\$ 3.32$.
