WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS The weighted index number of seventeen mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1925-100 was 92.6 for the week ending October 10th, as compared with 94.3 for the previous week. Eleven gold stocks rose from 58.6 to 59.4. Gold copper stocks represented by Amulet and Noranda fell from 277.2 to 263.3. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks fell from 61.9 to 59.9. Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:-Hollinger rose from \$5.44 to \$5.47. McIntyre from \$13.99 to \$14.03. Lake Shore from \$20.55 to \$21.10 and Teck-Hughes from \$5.28 to \$5.57. Coniaurum fell from  $40\phi$  to  $35\phi$ , Dome from \$9.08 to \$8.92, Sylvanite from  $73\phi$  to  $67\phi$  and Wright-Hargreaves from \$1.45 to \$1.42. Average weekly prices were lower for both of the gold copper stocks. Amulet fell from \$2.98 to \$2.89 and Noranda from \$52.89 to \$50.17. In the silver and miscellaneous group Nipissing fell from \$2.16 to \$2.11 and Mining Corporation from \$3.93 to \$3.74. Coniagas rose from 93¢ to 95¢
