WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

1926 = 100

The weighted index of seventeen mining stocks, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926-100, was 127.9 for the week ending March 7th, as compared with 124.7 for the week ending February 28th.

Gold copper stocks, represented by Amulet and Noranda, rose from 321.1 to 322.3. Eleven gold stocks rose from 86.2 to 89.7. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks rose from 84.6 to 88.2.

Among the gold stocks the average weekly prices behaved as follows:Dome rose from \$9.77 to \$10.28, McIntyre from \$20.80 to \$21.63, Lake Shore from \$22.84 to \$25.62 and Teck-Hughes from \$9.36 to \$9.31.

Average weekly prices were lower for one of the gold stocks and higher for the other. Amulet fell from \$2.54 to \$2.43 while Noranda rose from \$62.27 to \$62.67.

In the silver and miscellaneous group the average price of Nipissing rose from \$3.08 to \$3.28 and Mining Corporation from \$5.13 to \$5.47.
