## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

The weighted index of seventeen mining stocks, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 111.9 for the week ending April 4th as compared with 110.4 for the previous week.

Gold copper stocks, represented by Amulet and Noranda, fell from 274.5 to 269.8. Eleven gold stocks rose from 78.4 to 81.3. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks rose from 74.6 to 75.3.

Among the gold stocks the average weekly prices behaved as follows:-Hollinger rose from \$7.42 to \$7.58, Lake Shore from \$22.88 to \$25.34, Teck-Hughes from \$8.58 to \$8.80 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$1.81 to \$1.87. Premier declined from \$1:70 to \$1.66, McIntyre from \$19.37 to \$19.16 and Sylvanite from \$1:75 to \$1.671

Average weckly prices were lower for both of the gold copper stocks. Amulet declined from \$1.71 to \$1.63 and Noranda from \$53.92 to \$53.06.

In the sitver and miscellaneous group the average price of Nipissing fell from \$2.92 to \$2.75 and Coniagas from \$1.31 to \$1.19.
