WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

The weighted index of seventeen mining stocks, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926-100, was 113.1 for the week ending May 2nd, as compared with 112.9 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 83.4 to 83.8. Gold copper stocks, represented by Amulet and Noranda, fell from 266.1 to 265.8. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks fell from 76.2 to 75.4.

Among the gold stocks the average weekly prices behaved as follows:Premier rose from \$1.70 to \$1.90, Dome from \$10.09 to \$10.20 and Hollinger from \$7.21 to \$7.35. McIntyre fell from \$19.04 to \$18.77, Kirkland Lake from \$1.09 to \$1.06, Lake Shore from \$26.87 to \$26.82, Sylvanite from \$1.73 to \$1.69 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$1.85

Average weekly prices were lower for both of the gold copper stocks. Amulet fell from \$1.79 to \$1.76 and Noranda from \$52.17 to \$52.14.

In the silver and miscellaneous group the average price of Nipissing rose from \$2.95 to \$3.04 while Mining Corporation declined from \$4.56 to \$4.42.
