WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

The weighted index number of seventeen mining stocks, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 102.3 for the week ending June 13th as compared with 101.1 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 70.6 to 71.0. Gold copper stocks represented by Amulet and Noranda rose from 257.5 to 263.1. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks rose from 68.8 to 69.0.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:Premier rose from \$1.54 to \$1.57. Kirkland Lake from 85¢ to 91¢, Lake Shore from \$23.05 to \$23.55, Teck-Hughes from \$8.23 to \$8.27 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$1.34 to \$1.36. Hollinger fell from \$5.83 to \$5.74 and McIntyre from \$16.66 to \$16.28.

Average weekly prices were higher for both gold copper stocks. Noranda rose from \$51.28 to \$52.29 and Amulet from \$1.16 to \$1.26.

In the silver and miscellaneous group the average price of Nipissing rose from \$2.54 to \$2.62.
