WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

The weighted index number of seventeen mining stocks, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 109.4 for the week ending July 4th as compared with 107.7 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 73.8 to 73.6. Gold copper stocks represented by Amulet and Noranda rose from 281.7 to 293.8. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks fell from 71.8 to 69.7.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:-Lake Shore rose from \$25.84 to \$26.00 and Teck-Hughes from \$8.42 to \$8.60. Hollinger fell from \$5.65 to \$5.53, McIntyre from \$16.45 to \$15.93 and Sylvanite from \$1.07 to 94¢.

Average weekly prices were higher for both gold copper stocks. Noranda rose from \$56.11 to \$58.60 and Amulet from \$1.28 to \$1.30.

In the silver and miscellaneous group the average price of Coniagas fell from \$1.65 to \$1.21 and Mining Corporation from \$4.16 to \$4.13.
