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## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMEERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

The weighted index number of seventeen mining stccks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926 . 100 was $106 . b$ for the week ending September 12th, as compered with 107.9 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 64.4 to 64.3. Gcld copper stocks represented by Amulet and Noranda fell from 332.1 to 325.1. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks rose from 64.9 to 65.8 .

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:Lake Shore rose from $\$ 22.79$ to $\$ 23.16$, Teck-Hughes from $\$ 5.80$ to $\$ 6.00$ and $\pi r i g h t$ Hargreaves from $\$ 1.49$ to $\$ 1.56$. Dcme fell from $\$ 9.93$ to $\$ 9.73$. Hollinger from $\$ 6.12$ to $\$ 5.81$, McIntyre from $\$ 14.63$ to $\$ 14.22$, Kirkland Lake from $68 \phi$ to $62 \phi$ and Sylvanite from $86 \phi$ to $82 \phi$.

Average weekly prices were higher for one of the gcld copper stocks and lower for the other. Amulet rose from $\$ 2.58$ to $\$ 2.83$ while Noranda fell from $\$ 64.59$ to $\$ 02.84$.

In the silver and miscellanecus grcup price of Nipissing rose from $\$ 2.15$ to $\$ 2.36$ and Coniagas from $\$ 1.16$ to $\$ 1.18$. Mining Corporation fell frcm $\$ 4.16$ to
$\$ 4.11$.


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
