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## WEIGHIYD INDDX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING SIOCKS

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1926=100
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The weighted index number of seventeen mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base $1926=100$ was 59.9 for the week ending November 6 th, as compered with 60.5 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 58.3 to 57.7. Gold copper stocks represented by Amulet and Noranda fell from 77.5 to 76.3 . Four silver and miscellaneous stocks rose from 25.8 to 26.2

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Premier fell from $80 \phi$ to $78 \phi$. McIntyre from $\$ 17.93$ to $\$ 17.79$, Kirkland Lake from $42 \phi$ to $40 \phi$, Lake Shore from $\$ 21.72$ to $\$ 21.18$. Teck-Hughes from $\$ 6.02$ to $\$ 5.98$ and Mright-Fargreaves from $\$ 1.73$ to $\$ 1.69$. Coniaurum rose from $32 \phi$ to $35 \phi$. Dome from $\$ 8.34$ to $\$ 8.62$, Hollinger from $\$ 5.78$ to $\$ 5.82$ and Sylvanite from $58 \phi$ to $60 \phi$.

Average weekly prices were lower for one of the gold copper stocks and unchanged for the other. Amulet remained at 29ф, while Noranda fell from $\$ 15.91$ to $\$ 15.67$.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, N1pissing rose from $\$ 1.06$ to $\$ 1.12$.
