The weimhted index number of seventeen mining stocks computed $b$ the Dominio:. Bureau of Statistics on the base of $1926=100$ was 56.7 for the week ending December 18 th, as compared with 59.4 for tho previous wook.

Sleven gold stocks fell from 57.8 to 56.1. Gold copper stocks reprosortcd by dmulet and Noranda foll from 69.7 to 62.3. Four silver and iniscellaneous stocks fell from 31.5 to 29.3 .

Among the gold stocks the weokly averace pricos bohaved as follows:Promior fell from $76 \phi$ to $70 \phi$, Dome from $\$ 8.58$ to $\$ 8.49$, Eollinger from $\$ 6.28$ to $\$ 5.9$. UcIntyre from $\$ 18.35$ to $\$ 18.18$, Vipond Consolidatod from $89 \phi$ to $86 \phi$, Lake Shore from $\$ 21.43$ to $\$ 21.05$, Sylvanite from 50 to 44 and Teck-5umes from $\$ 5.65$ to $\$ 5.44$.

Average weekly pricos were lower for both of the fold copper stocles. dmal foll from $31 \phi$ to $\mathbf{2 7 \phi}$ and Noranda from $\$ 14.34$ to $\$ 12.83$.

In the silvor and miscellancous group, Nipissing foll from $\$ 1.26$ to $\$ 1.16$ and Kining Corporation from $\$ 1.54$ to $\$ 1.34$.
