## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

1926 = 100

The weighted index number of seventeen mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100 was 86.4 for the week ending February 6th, as compared with 83.3 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 61.0 to 62.8. Gold copper stocks represented by Amulet and Noranda rose from 201.1 to 211.9. Four silver and miscellameous stocks rose from 49.4 to 50.0

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:- McIntyre rose from \$17.53 to \$17.73, Kirkland Lake from  $75\phi$  to  $77\phi$ , Lake Shore from \$21.53 to \$22.99, Teck-Hughes from \$5.73 to \$6.09 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$1.81 to \$1.84. Premier fell from \$1.53 to \$1.48, Dome from \$8.13 to \$8.00, Hollinger from \$5.56 to \$5.53 and Sylvanite from  $71\phi$  to  $64\phi$ .

Average weekly prices were higher for one of the gold copper stocks and unchanged for the other. Noranda rose from \$39.21 to \$41.46 while Amulet remained at

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Nipissing rose from \$1.66 to \$1.73 and Mining Corporation from \$2.83 to \$2.85.
