WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

1926 - 100

The weighted index number of seventeen mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926 = 100 was 78.0 for the week ending June 5th, as compared with 76.7 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 64.9 to 66.7. Gold copper stocks represented by Amulet and Noranda fell from 144.5 to 143.9. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks fell from 35.5 to 35.2.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Premier rose from 93¢ to \$1.04, Dome from \$8.87 to \$9.09, Hollinger from \$6.53 to \$6.40, Vipond Consolidated from \$1.25 to \$1.34, Kirkland Lake from 62¢ to 72¢, Lake Shore from \$22.55 to \$22.76, Teck-Hughes from \$6.73 to \$7.09 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$2.08 to \$2.21.

Average weekly prices were higher for one of the gold copper stocks and lower for the other. Amulet rose from 82¢ to 84¢ while Noranda full from \$28.87 to \$28.73.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Nipissing fell from 1.52 to \$1.46. Mining Corporation rose from \$1.61 to \$1.63.
