## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS 1926=100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 55.6 for the week ending October 8th, as compared with 54.8 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 54.4 to 57.0, four gold-copper stocks fell from 57.8 to 52.8, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 31.1 to 30.2.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:Coniarum mounted from 38¢ to 40¢, Hollinger from \$5.01 to \$5.24, Lake Shore from \$22.81
to \$24.30, McIntyre from \$16.20 to \$17.45, Teck-Hughes from \$5.16 to \$5.57 and WrightHargreaves from \$2.52 to \$2.60. Dome dropped from \$9.35 to \$9.27, Kirkland Lake from
59¢ to 55¢, Premier from 47¢ to 42¢, Sylvanite from 70¢ to 66¢ and Vipond Consolidated
from 64¢ to 50¢.

Average weekly prices were lower for two and unchanged for two of the gold-corper stocks. Hudson Bay declined from \$2.67 to \$2.33 and Noranda from \$14.35 to \$13.18.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Castle-Trethewey fell from  $19\phi$  to  $17\phi$ , Keely from  $29\phi$  to  $24\phi$  and Nipissing from \$1.25 to \$1.23.
