The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base $1926=100$, was 55.6 for the week ending October 8 th, as compared with 54.8 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 54.4 to 57.0 , four gold-copper stocks fell from 57.8 to 52.8 , and five silver and miscellanenus stocks from 31.1 to 30.2 .

Anong the gold stocks the weekly averase prices behaved as follows:Coniarum mounted from $38 \phi$ to $40 \phi$, Hollinger firom $\$ 5.01$ to $\$ 5.24$, Lake Shore from $\$ 22.81$ to $\$ 24.30$. McIntyre from $\$ 16.20$ to $\$ 27.45$, Teck--Ju, ies from $\$ 5.16$ to $\$ 5.57$ and TrightFargreaves from $\$ 2.52$ to $\$ 2.60$. Dome dropped from $\$ 9.35$ to $\$ 9.27$, Kirkland Lake from $59 \phi$ to $55 \phi$. Premier from 47 to $42 \phi$, Sylvanite from $70 \phi$ to $66 \phi$ and $V$ pond Consolitated from 64 to $50 \phi$.

Average weekly prices were lower for two and unchanged for two of the goldcomoer stocks. Fudson Bay declined from $\$ 2.67$ t.0 $\$ 2.33$ and Noranda from $\$ 14.35$ to \$13.18.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Castle-Trethewey fell from $19 \$$ to 17申, Reel from 29 to 24 and Nipissing from $\$ 1.25$ to $\$ 1.23$.
