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## NIIGHTHD INDEX NMBERS OT 20 MNING STOCKS <br> $1926=100$

The weighted index number of twenty-mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base $1926 \mathbf{1 0 0}$, was 65.7 for the week ending November 19th, as compared with 67.7 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 66.2 to 65.1 , four gold-copper stocks from 75.3 to 71.1 , and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 36.2 to 32.0 .

Anong the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:Hollinger declined from $\$ 6.32$ to $\$ 6.26$, Lake Shore from $\$ 29.12$ to $\$ 29.05$. McIntyre from $\$ 20.42$ to $\$ 19.47$. Premier from 74 to $67 \phi$. Teck-Hughes from $\$ 5.91$ to $\$ 5.57$ and Vipond Consolidated from $61 \phi$ to $58 \phi$. Wright-Hargreaves rose from $\$ 3.02$ to $\$ 3.12$.

Average weekly prices were lower for all of the gold-conper stocks. Amulet dropped from $25 \phi$ to $22 \phi$, Fudson Bay from $\$ 4.03$ to $\$ 3.53$, Noranda from $\$ 17.90$ to $\$ 27.33$ and Sherritt-Gordon from 77 to $72 \phi$.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, CastlemTrethewey fell from 27 to 21申. Keely from $31 \phi$ to 24 , Mining Corporation from $\$ 1.74$ to $\$ 1.57$ and Nipissing from \$1. 52 to $\$ 3.31$.
