## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS

1926 - 100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926-100, was 57.1 for the week ending Lecember 17th, as compared with 61.4 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 61:1 to 57.3, four gold-copper stocks from 66.0 to 59.8, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 28.2 to 26.5.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:— Dome declined from \$9.84 to \$9.33, Hollinger from \$5.84 to \$5.34, Kirkland Lake from 51¢ to 42¢, Lake Shore from \$27.82 to \$26.72, McIntyre from \$18.72 to \$17.08, Premier from 63¢ to 59¢, Sylvanite from 62¢ to 57¢, Teck-Hughes from \$5.11 to \$4.82, Vipond Consolidated from 44¢ to 39¢ and Wright-Hargreaves from \$2.97 to \$2.74.

Average weekly prices were lower for all of the gold-copper stocks. Amulet dropped from 19¢ to 17¢, Hudson Bay from \$2.93 to \$2.73, Noranda from \$16.74 to \$15.02 and Sherritt-Gordon from 62¢ to 59¢.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Mining Corporation fell from \$1.41 to \$1.21 and Nipissing from \$1.14 to \$1.11 while Keely rose from 24¢ to 28¢.
