WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS

1926 = 100

The weighted index number of seventeen mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base of 1926=100 was 72.7 for the week ending February 5th, as compared with 72.4 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 72.2 to 72.1. Gold copper stocks represented by Amulet and Noranda Pose from 80.3 to 82.7. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks rose from 32.7 to 33.2.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:-Coniaurum fell from $60 \, \phi$ to $58 \, \phi$, Dome from \$10.27 to \$10.21, McIntyre from \$23.23 to \$22.45, Vipond Consolidated from \$1117 to \$1.13 and Kirkland Lake from $75 \, \phi$ to $73 \, \phi$: Hollinger rose from \$8.21 to \$8.34 and Lake Shore from \$26.00 to \$26.06.

Average weekly prices were higher for one of the gold copper stocks and unchanged for the other. Noranda rose from \$16.64 to \$17.17 while Amulet remained at 34.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Nipissing rose from \$1.29 to \$1.45. Mining Corporation fell from \$1.85 to \$1.81.
