WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS 1926 = 100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base of 1926-100, was 69.7 for the week ending June 25th, as compared with 67.4 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 68.2 to 68.7, four gold-copper stocks from 69.0 to 77.6 and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 29.9 to 30.9.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:—
Dome mourted from \$11.68 to \$12.10. Kirkland Lake from 61¢ to 64¢. Lake Shore from \$25.64 to \$25.73, Sylvanite from 69¢ to 74¢, Teck-Hughes from \$6.73 to \$6.84, Vipond Consolidated from 77¢ to 81¢ and Wright-Hargreaves from \$2.77 to \$2.83. Hollinger declined from \$6.81 to \$6.77 and McIntyre from \$23.11 to \$22.87.

Average weekly prices were higher for all of the gold-copper stocks. Amulet rose from 15ϕ to 23ϕ , Hudson Bay from \$3.47 to \$4.17, Noranda from \$16.75 to \$18.39 and Sherritt-Gordon from 53ϕ to 61ϕ .

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Mining Corporation rose from \$1.80 to \$1.89 and Nipissing from 87ϕ to 94ϕ .
