

WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS 1926 = 100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base of 1926=100, was 68.6 for the week ending July 16th, as compared with 70.2 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 68.0 to 67.2, four gold-copper stocks from 81.9 to 77.8, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 33.3 to 31.7.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Coniarum declined from 31ϕ to 25ϕ , Dome from \$11.61 to \$11.52, Hollinger from \$6.65 to \$6.33, Kirklard Lake from 64ϕ to 60ϕ , McIntyre from \$21.80 to \$21.74, Sylvanite from 69ϕ to 67ϕ , Teck-Hughes from \$6.70 to \$6.68 and Vipond Consolidated from 78ϕ to 75ϕ . Lake Shore mounted from \$26.62 to \$26.79.

Average weekly prices were lower for all of the gold-copper stocks. Amulet fell from 21ϕ to 17ϕ , Hudson Bay from \$4.53 to \$4.13, Noranda from \$19.21 to \$18.57 and Sherritt-Gordon from 68ϕ to 62ϕ .

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Mining Corporation dropped from \$1.88 to \$1.75 and Nipissing from \$1.23 to \$1.20.
