WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS

1926 = 100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 56.6 for the week ending February 11th, as compared with 58.4 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 58.6 to 57.0, four gold-copper stocks from 62.6 to 60.0, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 23.6 to 21.7.

Among the gold stocks the weekly average prices behaved as follows:— Dome declined from \$9.90 to \$9.72, Hollinger from \$5.24 to \$5.06, Kirkland Lake from 49ϕ to 45ϕ , Lake Shore from \$28.7 to \$28.34, McIntyre from \$18.05 to \$17.61, Premier from 60ϕ to 57ϕ , Sylvanite from 60ϕ to 55ϕ , Teck-Hughes from \$4.55 to \$4.35, Vipond Consolidated from 36ϕ to 32ϕ and Wright-Hargreaves from \$2.78 to \$2.74.

Average weekly prices were lower for all of the gold-copper stocks. Amulet dropped from 17ϕ to 16ϕ , Hudson Bay from \$2.48 to \$2.31, Noranda from \$16.34 to \$15.85 and Sherritt-Gordon from 61ϕ to 56ϕ .

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Mining Corporation fell from \$1.21 to \$1.02 and Nipissing from 98ϕ to 96ϕ .
